Dead Frog Player Code of Conduct

- Expect to set up and take down equipment at all practices. Care and respect all equipment provided as part of the program.

- Playing time is decided by each individual coach and is not guaranteed for any player. Coaches will attempt to put the most competitive team out on the court but also give each individual the opportunity to improve in game situations.
- Remain with your team during time spent at the actual tournament location. All players are expected to remain at the tournament until all officiating assignments are completed. We encourage that all Dead Frog participants remain at the tournament until all Dead Frog teams are finished, but this is not required.
- You are a representative of Dead Frog. Actions and behaviors in person and via social media, should always reflect positively on the yourself, team and Dead Frog Volleyball.
